**Purpose or Objective**

To update and edit the Class Constitution as appropriate by following the age division changes in the Class. To change the Class insignia. To replace the text which created a confusion and misinterpretations with the explicit wording.

**Proposal 1**

Replace the current Class Insignia as follows:

1.2 The iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Insignia shall be



**Current Position**

Currently the Class has two Insignias, one for Youth fleet and Another one for Junior fleet.



**Reason**

The new Class insignia with both age divisions shown on the logo, is more practicable to use and looks better too.

### Proposal 2

#### 3. MEMBERSHIP

Delete the paragraphs 3.2, 3.3 and 3.4 and replace with the following:

3.2 Full Membership may be granted to **World Sailing Member National Authority (MNA) or National Class Association (NCA) who have delegated authority to govern the Class in each respective country.**

3.3 **Individual Membership may be granted by the class Executive Committee to individuals coming from a country where an NCA does not exist or MNA is not a member of iQFOiL Class.**

The following paragraphs are reordered accordingly.

### Current Position

3.2 Full Membership may be granted to those National iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Associations (NCA) established in a country, and recognized as such by the World S a i l i n g Member National Authority (MNA) for that country.

3.3 In the absence of a NCA, Full Membership may be granted to an MNA controlling the iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class activity in a country.

3.4 Individual Membership may be granted by the class Executive Committee to individuals that are not represented by either an NCA or an MNA.

### Reason

Better and clearer wording.  
Three paragraphs are combined to two.

### Proposal 3

#### 4. MEMBERSHIP FEES

Delete the paragraph 4.2 and replace with the following:

4.2 **The Annual Fees shall be paid each year between 1<sup>st</sup> January and 28<sup>th</sup> February and, in any case, before the first Championship of the year. A National Class Association or an Individual Member not having paid the Annual Membership Fee may have their rights and benefits granted by the Constitution suspended following a decision of the Executive Committee. A National Class Association or an Individual Member with outstanding fees shall automatically recover their rights and benefits once the Class has received payment of all the Annual Membership Fee dues.**

### Current Position

4.2 All subscriptions are due on 1 January each year, and shall be paid by 28 February.

### Reason

Much better and clearer wording, which eliminates any confusion to how to interpret the rule.

### Proposal 4

#### **6. GENERAL ASSEMBLY & MEETINGS**

Delete the paragraphs 6.3 and 6.7 and replace with the following:

- 6.3 Ordinary meetings of the General Assembly shall be held annually, usually at the class World Championships, or as decided by the iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Executive Committee, **including the option for remote meetings via teleconference system.**
- 6.7 Each iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Full Member delegate has one vote, but may represent no more than two other iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Full Members from whom he or she had received a proxy vote mandate. Alternatively, iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Full Members may submit their vote by e-mail. Proxy mandates and email votes shall be received by the iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Executive Secretary at least 24 hours before the date and time of the General Assembly as posted on the official class web site, and shall be signed by either the Chairman or Executive Secretary of the iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Full Member. **No proxy vote mandates can be accepted when the General Assembly will be held remotely via teleconference system.**

### Current Position

- 6.3 Ordinary meetings of the General Assembly shall be held annually, usually at the class World Championships, or as decided by the iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Executive Committee.
- 6.7 Each iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Full Member delegate has one vote, buy may represent no more than two other iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Full Members from whom he or she had received a proxy vote mandate. Alternatively, iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Full Members may submit their vote by e-mail. Proxy mandates and email votes shall be received by the iQFOiL Youth & Junior Executive Secretary at least 24 hours before the date and time of the General Assembly as posted on the official class web site, and shall be signed by either the Chairman or Secretary of the iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Full Member

### Reason

Allows to hold the General Assemblies online.  
When General Assembly will be held remotely then there is no need for proxies.

**Proposal 5**

**7. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

Delete the paragraphs 7.2 and replace with the following:

- 7.2 Candidates for the iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Executive Committee are elected for a **4-year** period, and may stand for re-election.

**Current Position**

- 7.2 Candidates for the iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Executive Committee are elected for a 1 year period, and may stand for re-election.

**Reason**

1-year term is not motivating and is too short to carry out the strategies of the Executive Committee,
