**For U19 Youth Fleet to change the foil mast to carbon material.**

➤ **ARG - Gonzalo COSTA HOEVEL – Class Manager**

We have had some discussions over the last month with some Members about the Allu/Carbon mast/vertical for the U19 group.

We have received the requisite number of requests (10) for an EGM. Those were received from ARU, CZE, FRA, HUN, ISR, ITA, LAT, POL, SVJ, USA.

We have 28 Members so the 1/3 is full-filled to call the meeting.

Below I have listed the names of the full members (28):

What was said at the Pre-Meeting Tuesday 23rd at 14.00 CET :

**Carbon Mast +**

- Carbon has more durability than Aluminium
- It allows to train Youth boys and girls with senior girls quite easily
- It allows an easier transition to senior practice
- We will have a second hand market on the carbon foils thanks to the seniors

**Carbon Mast –**

- Carbon masts will be more expensive
- Therefore it can endanger the number of young sailors taking part in the Class

➤ **ISR – Ronnie MEIR – Class President**

The biggest problem for the oponent is the price.

But if you think about U19 sailors going to compete on the senior events, they will save some money because they will already have an IQFoil carbon mast.

Besides, carbon has more durability

➤ **GER – Michael GOTZKE**

Will the carbon mast be identical to the IQFoil senior mast ?

➤ **ARG - Gonzalo COSTA HOEVEL – Class Manager**

Yes it will

➤ **GBR – Jeremy HAWKINS**

GBR concern is more about the cost for U17 to go to U19 : They will need to buy a new foil mast + a new front wing + a new rig

➤ **HUN – Lorand UTASSY**

Answering to GBR - Jeremy HAWKINS :

Remember that before we needed to go from Techno 293OD to RS:X : We had to change everything and it was much more expensive

➤ **USA – Jerome SAMSON**

Are the kids competing with an aluminium mast still be authorised to race with it on IQFoil Youth international events ?

➤ **ARG - Gonzalo COSTA HOEVEL – Class Manager**

kids competing with an aluminium mast will still be authorised to race with it on National events but NOT on IQFoil Youth international events : There will have too much difference in performance

➤ **GER – Michael GOTZKE**

How will the Aluminium masts be exchanged ?

➤ **ARG - Gonzalo COSTA HOEVEL – Class Manager**

There will be a special mast exchange offer for kids who have already bought the aluminum mast, which will be organized through distributors and dealers :

- The aluminum mast can be exchanged for free for Starboard's updated aluminum version, which is thicker, more rigid and has improved fixations.
- More significantly, the aluminum mast can also be upgraded to carbon for 290€ (not including tax) for the sailors that have bought the youth foil.

Regarding the timeline, the priority for the carbon upgrade will go to those sailors who attended this year's Youth Worlds or Youth Europeans. There are 600 carbon masts available immediately, and the rest will be upgraded following Starboard's production timeline. For those youth competitors who own more than one aluminum mast, only one can be upgraded for the time being.

The upgrades will be organized through distributors and dealers.

What about the sailors doing the transition from U17 to U19 ?
